

Subject: BODY FLUSH / HANDGUN HOSE REEL VALVE OPERATION

PRODUCTS AFFECTED:

Models: Camel **Affected Units:** 2021 Model Year or Newer

EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

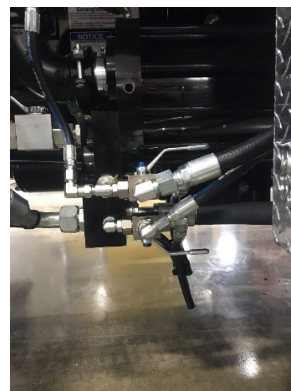
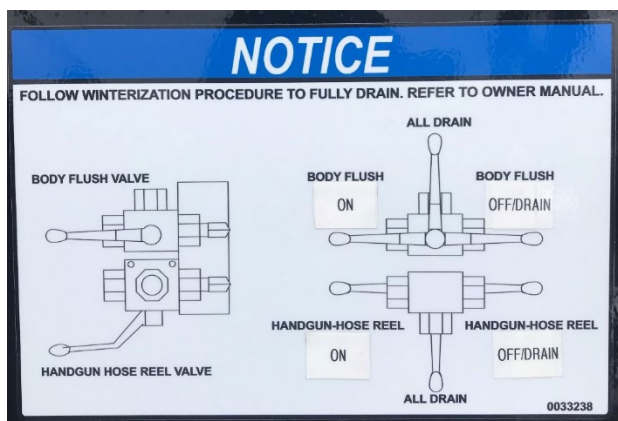
Description of Update:

The new Camel Max HD design required that the water pump be moved forward 24” and outward 2”. This has resulted in a slightly different operation of both the body flush and handgun hose reel valves. The direction of both valves is reversed from previous models equipped with a single-piston water pump.
